CURRENT CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- What:** Geneva Rock will be reconstructing the roadway, making drainage improvements and installing sidewalks from Honeycut Rd to 2300 East along 3900 South.
- How:** To facilitate the work, traffic will be shifted to the south side of the roadway and will be restricted to two 10 foot lanes.
- Why:** The contractor will be improving drainage and removing the top layers of asphalt in preparation of roadway excavation on the north side of the roadway.
- When:** Traffic shifting will take place on Monday, July 27, 2009 and will continue through September.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather or equipment related issues.

The project team is coordinating with the Post Office and Sanitation Services for mail delivery and trash pick up along 3900 South.

UTA Bus Route: For safety reasons, UTA will be detouring route 39 during the length of this project. Buses will use 4500 South from Highland Drive to 2300 East.

20 mph Speed Limit: For safety reasons, the enforced speed limit during construction is **20 mph**. Motorists should reduce speeds, be aware of their surroundings, and be prepared to stop at any time.
