CURRENT CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- What:** Geneva Rock will be finishing with the milling along the north side of 3900 South. Throughout this week, they will be working on the storm drain from Honeycut Rd. to 2000 East and they will begin installing new signals at 2000 East and 2300 East.
- Where:** Along the entire length of 3900 South, from Honeycut Rd. to 2300 East. Some excavation and milling will extend into the side streets.
- Why:** To prepare for the new roadway and sidewalks.
- When:** Traffic shifting began on Monday, July 27, 2009 and will continue through November. Storm drain reconstruction began on August 5, 2009 and will continue throughout the week.

This schedule is subject to change due to weather or equipment related issues.

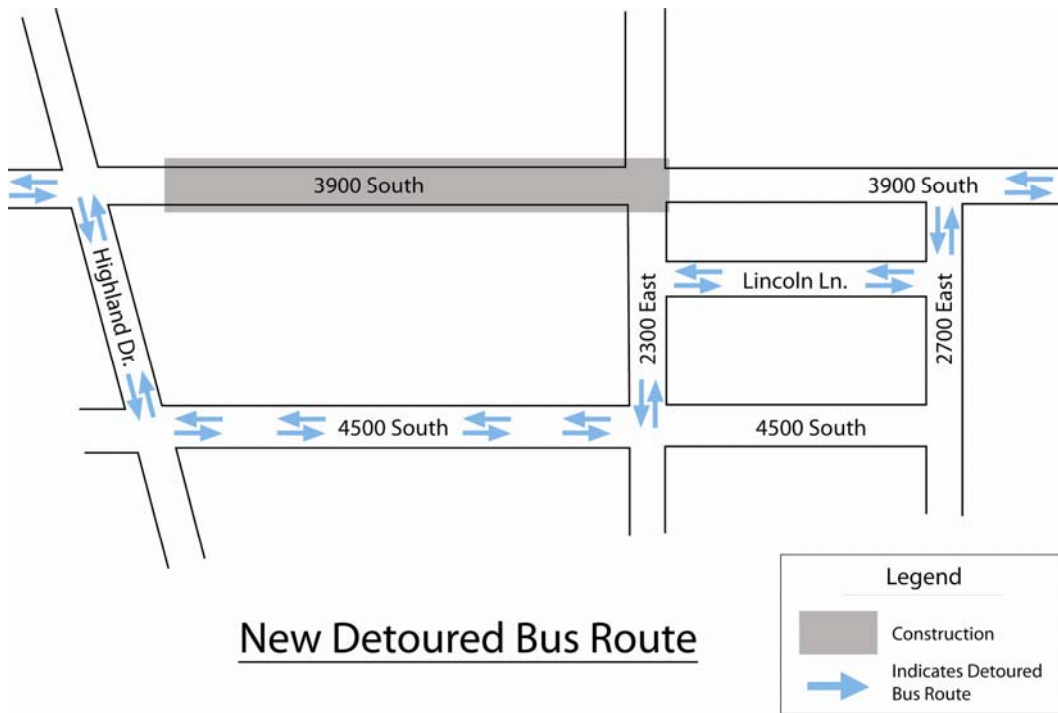
30 mph Speed Limit: For safety reasons, the enforced speed limit during construction is **30 mph**. Motorists should reduce speeds, be aware of their surroundings, and be prepared to stop at any time.

Mail Delivery: Through the duration of the construction project, the US Post Office will not be delivering mail to the resident and businesses with mailboxes located on 3900 South. Mail will be held at the Holladay Branch, located at 2350 Arbor Lane (approx 4750 South), Salt Lake City, UT 84117.

Garbage Pick Up: During construction on the North side of 3900 South, residents/businesses located on the north side should carry their garbage cans through the portion of the road that is under construction to the edge of the pavement, in line with the orange construction barrels. The contractor is willing to help residents along 3900 South who may not be able to accomplish this task. Residents/businesses on the South side may place their garbage cans in their typical pickup locations. Beginning on Tuesday, August 4, 2009, garbage

will be picked up promptly at 7 am. Please contact the public information team if you would like assistance.

UTA Bus Route: For safety reasons, UTA will be redirecting the detour route for route 39 during the length of this project. Buses will use 4500 South from Highland Drive to 2300 East to Lincoln Lane to 2700 East to 3900 South.



Cyclists & Pedestrians: The overall goal of the project is to make 3900 South safer for cyclists, pedestrians and commuters. Although we would like to accommodate cyclists and pedestrians during construction, it is not always feasible. For your safety as a cyclist or pedestrian, please consider an alternate route.
